What?

Why?

Feeding America projects a 56% increase in New Jersey's food insecurity rate as a direct result of the pandemic, higher than the expected increases nationwide and in neighboring states.

This translates to an additional 430,000 New Jersey residents becoming food insecure—a total of 1.2 million food insecure residents.
